1. The problem statement isn't clear.
2. Results section is rather brief taking into consideration the wealth of data that has been collected.
3. Discussion section sounds like a literature review instead of Discussion. Reflective comments are lacking in this section.
4. Conclusion section is too brief. Some parts of the Discussion section can be moved to Conclusion section.
5. There are many language errors, particularly referencing/deixis errors to the extent that it impeded comprehension.
6. I can't see the novelty of this study. Perhaps it is in the manuscript, but it is not well and clearly written.
