Comments to the Corresponding Author

1. This article reviews relevant literature and discusses the main theory well (Wenger, 1998, 2010). However, the result presentation is not relying on text of the story from the subjects, which is the common practice of narrative analysis, therefore, the result seems to be only the author's summarized interpretation of the narrative. When direct quotes are not provided, the analysis will lack substantiation and it decontextualize the narrative, to say the least. The rewritten experience by the researcher/author can mis-capture the detail of the experience despite the verification said to be done by the author.
2. In the method of narrative inquiry usually uses free association narrative interview method or biographic-narrative interpretive interview method. None was mentioned in method (Narrative interviewing)
3. Lack attention toward the linguistic phenomena as well as the story's overall sequential composition. This is the result of the absence of reference to the stories told by the subject (from interviews).
4. The multi-layered narrative analysis seems to be missing: both content and discourse.
5. Topical cohesiveness – should be based on words and sentences directly quoted from the source/story.

Comments to the Corresponding Author

Overall, this paper provides evidences to confirm Wenger's social learning theory of identity reconstruction. The abstract sufficiently summarized the study. Problem, significance, and objectives of study were adequately explained; as well as the literature were adequately reviewed. However, this paper has a major flaw which is the language was very poor in terms of the tenses used (past and present tense were used wrongly); appropriateness of the words used; structure of sentences which looked as if the author change the Indonesian words with English words but the structure of the sentences remained Indonesian. The author should send the article for proofreading, editing, and restructuring before sending for publication.
